DEFINITION OF ASSOCIATE DEGREES:

Students at College of the Sequoias who complete the appropriate requirements may earn either an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree. Both degrees represent significant levels of achievement and may be used by students who plan to start their careers immediately after graduating or, with proper planning and course selection, by those who plan to transfer to a four-year university.

Associate of Arts (AA) degree is granted to students majoring in the arts, humanities, and similar areas.

Associate of Science (AS) degree is granted to students majoring in agriculture, engineering, technology, the sciences, and related programs.

REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION:

1. **Units, Residency, and Scholarship Requirements:** A minimum of 60 units of college courses numbered 1-299 (**exception: ENGL 251 is the only English 200-level course that counts**), at least 15 of which must be taken in residence at College of the Sequoias, with a “C” (2.0) average.
2. **Major Requirements:** Completion of all courses required for the desired major (for specifics, see a counselor or the “Major and Certificate” section of the College of the Sequoias General Catalog).
3. **General Education Requirements:** Eighteen (18) units of general education, including at least three (3) units from each of the six areas listed on the reverse side of this document, are required. However, completion of the CSU or IGETC transfer general education requirements or general education requirements at any accredited university will fulfill the COS general education, subject, and competency requirements.
4. **Subject Requirements:**
 - A. **Physical Education:** Satisfactory completion of two units of Dance, Intercollegiate Athletics, or Physical Education general activity coursework is required. Students 21 years of age and over at the time of graduation are exempt from this requirement. A medical exemption is also available.
 - B. **Health and Wellness:** Satisfactory completion of HW 1, 7, or 104 is required. Degrees in Registered Nursing are exempt from this requirement. Veterans are also exempt with approved DD214 or DD295.
 - C. **American Institutions:** Satisfactory completion of HIST 17, 18, GOVT 5, or SSCI 276, or an equivalent course at an accredited college/university.
5. **Competency Requirements:** Students must establish competency in each of the following areas:
 - A. **Writing:** Completion of ENGL 1, 251, or BUS 184, or an equivalent course at an accredited college with a minimum of a “C” grade, **OR** earn a passing score on the CLEP English Examination. (Score of 500 or higher on the written test or 50 or higher on the computerized test.)
 - B. **Reading:** Completion of ENGL 1, 265AB, or an equivalent course at an accredited college with a minimum of a “C” grade, **OR** earn a score of 25 or higher on the APS Paper & Pencil Reading Placement Test, **OR** earn a score of 85 or higher on the CPT Computerized Reading Placement Test, **OR** earn a passing score on the CLEP English Examination. (Score of 500 or higher on the written test or 50 or higher on the computerized test.)
 - C. **Mathematics:** Completion of MATH 230 or 235 or a more advanced math course at COS, or an equivalent course at an accredited college with a minimum of a “C” grade **OR** high school algebra 1 and geometry (one each) with a minimum of a “C” grade **OR** pass the COS Math Competency Examination with a successful score (at least 70%) **OR** earn a passing score on the CLEP Mathematics Examination. (Score of 500 or higher on the written test or 50 or higher on the computerized test.)
