Associate Degree Graduation Requirements

1. Completion of a minimum of 60 semester units of acceptable college credits (numbered 50-299). Twelve units must be completed at Mendocino College. Overall grade point average of 2.0, "C" or better, in all degree applicable course work. Completion of the Mendocino College General Education pattern, an appropriate major as listed in the college catalog (minimum of 18 units) and institutional requirements. A maximum of 16 units of Work Experience can be counted as elective credit including a maximum of 6 units of General Work Experience. No more than eight elective semester units of Special Topic courses (numbered 88 or 188) may be counted towards a degree.
2. Transfer students completing either the CSU GE or the IGETC pattern have met the General Education requirements for an associate degree. In addition, they must also meet major and institutional requirements. Transfer students should consult with a counselor for appropriate courses to meet the major requirement.

4. **Written Expression:** *Business Office Technology* 170, *English* 80, or *English* 200 with a "C" or better
5. **Reading:** *Business Office Technology* 170, *English* 80, or *English* 200 with a "C" or better

CSU & UC Transfer General Education Requirements IGETC

Completion of IGETC prior to transfer (CSU or UC) may fulfill lower-division general education requirements at the receiving institution. All areas must be satisfied, and all courses must be completed with a grade of “C” or better before IGETC can be certified. IGETC is not appropriate for all programs and is not an admissions requirement to the UC system. Consult with a counselor for additional information about appropriate general education courses for your planned major and school.

The UC system recommends major preparation over completion of General Education requirements. Refer to resources such as a UC catalog or your Mendocino College counselor for appropriate pre-major coursework.
