No. 305

MENDOCINO - LAKE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

TOBACCO USE ON CAMPUS

In recognition of the importance of maintaining a clean and healthful environment and to reduce risk of fire, smoking and other tobacco use is only permitted on District property as specified in the Administrative Regulation.

This prohibition will be actively enforced in areas deemed by the Administration as containing hazardous materials where the presence of smoke constitutes a threat to health or safety and in any location closer than 20 feet from entrances, exits, and openable windows.

This policy also applies to the use of all tobacco products including cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, smokeless tobacco (chewing), snuff or any other form of tobacco which may be utilized for smoking, chewing, inhalation, or other manner of ingestion.
