CONTRACT EDUCATION

Mendocino College may offer contract education credit, not for credit, or non credit courses or services to public or private entities. (Education Code 78020)

Contract Education Programs may be established in state or out of state by agreement with any public or private agency, corporation, association, or any other person or body to provide specific education programs or training to meet specific needs of these bodies. (Education Code 78021)

Apportionment can only be collected if all statutory and regulatory conditions are met.

The Board encourages the College to work closely with local businesses, public entities and industry to meet the economic development and employment training and support service needs of the community.

In accord with this policy, the Board supports the provision of academic, vocational education, job training (or retraining), and employer specific contract education program.

The Superintendent/President is directed to develop appropriate procedures to implement this policy.
