COMMUNITY SERVICE CLASSES

Mendocino-Lake Community College District may offer community service classes, also known as Community Extension classes (ComEx).

The Board of Trustees encourages the Superintendent/President or designee to design Community Extension classes to provide for the "physical, mental, moral, economic or civil development of the individuals or groups enrolled therein."

In accordance with Education Code 78300 (c), General Fund monies may not be expended to establish and maintain community service classes. The District may charge students enrolled in community service classes a fee not to exceed the cost of maintaining said classes or may receive remuneration by contract, or monetary contributions or donations of individuals or groups.
