PPAC reviews Board Policies and Administrative Procedures (new and/or revised) with a minimum of two readings per policy. Following a first introduction to the proposed policy or policy revisions, PPAC members take proposed revisions to constituent groups for comments. PPAC members bring back comments to a second PPAC meeting and make recommendations for revisions to the Superintendent/President. The Superintendent/President takes recommendations into consideration and then forwards new or revised board policies to the Board of Trustees. Administrative Procedures are finalized by the Superintendent/President following the recommendation of PPAC members. (Note: Administrative Procedures do not go to the board for approval.) PPAC reviews the Academic Calendar using the same method.
