## REGISTERED NURSING PROGRAM

The Mendocino College Registered Nursing Program provides the education and training needed to prepare students to sit for the California Registered Nursing Licensure Exam (NCLEX-RN).

The program is four full-time semesters of courses completed after fulfillment of prerequisite and general education requirements.

**Applications are available each February and are due by the posted deadline in March for Fall Admissions.**

### PROGRAM EXPENSES

- ✓ Tuition
- ✓ Textbooks

(including watch, stethoscope, bandage scissors, and uniform patch)
- ✓ Transportation to/from clinical sites
- ✓ Lodging for out-of-town clinical sites (if needed)
- ✓ Fees for content testing and supply kits
- ✓ Graduation costs

## PREREQUISITES FOR ADMISSION TO THE NURSING PROGRAM

**Completion of the following with a "C" or better:**

- BIO 230 - Anatomy \*
- BIO 231 - Physiology \*
- BIO 259 - Microbiology \*

**\*Sciences must meet recency requirement. Grades of "A" or "B" are valid for 10 years, grade "C" is valid for 5 years.**

- HLH 214 or HLH 215 - Nutrition
- SOC 200, SOC 201, or ANT 201 - Sociology
- ETH 202 or ETH 235 - Ethnic Studies
- ENGL C1000 - English
- COMM C1000 or COMM 210 - Speech
- PSYC C1000, PSYC 210, PSYC 215, or CDV 200 - Psychology
- Completion of RN Program Prerequisites, General Education, and Institutional Requirements before applying
- High School Diploma or Equivalent (GED)
- Clear Background Screening
- US Citizenship or Permanent Residency with Valid Social Security Number or Individual Tax Identification Number
- Successful TEAS Exam passing score of at least 62%

## OTHER INFORMATION/ REQUIREMENTS

- Post acceptance physical exam, lab tests & immunizations.
- Science prerequisite courses must be at least 4 semester units each, with a lab. Course may be online but lab must be in person (COVID in-person lab exemption Spring 2020 - Spring 2022 only).
- Interested individuals should meet with an academic counselor early for advisement on prerequisites and General Education Courses.
- Transportation to clinical sites is the responsibility of the student. Clinical hours may include day, evenings, or weekend hours.
- Acceptance based on overall college GPA, English GPA, as well as Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology GPA. Lottery based for applicants who meet grade requirements.
- 18-20 students accepted each Fall.
- Grade forgiveness for poor grades on transcript if grade is over 7-years old; non-passing grades in the sciences can be eliminated.
- On-site pre-application workshop is required.
