

SPECIAL ADMISSION NONRESIDENT TUITION EXEMPTION REQUEST

For Eligible Special Part-Time Students

Special admission students who are determined to be nonresidents may be exempt from paying nonresident tuition.

- The term "special admission student" refers to concurrently enrolled K-12 students who have been recommended by the principal (or designee) of the pupil's school and have parental permission to attend a community college during any session or term, and are enrolled in 11.0 or fewer units per semester, in accordance with California Education Code Section 76001.
- This exemption does not apply to special admission students enrolled in more than 11.0 units in a semester.
- This exemption does not apply to categories of students who would be precluded from qualifying for AB 540 nonresident tuition exemption:
 - Students who reside outside of California and enroll via Distance Education;
 - Students on most nonimmigrant visas (e.g., F-1 International Student visas, etc.). T and U nonimmigrant visas are eligible for this exemption.
- Students receiving this exemption do not receive resident status for the purpose of tuition or financial aid, but are exempt from nonresident tuition under AB 2364.
- Students may request residency reclassification in a future semester.

- I am a nonimmigrant alien as defined by federal law. [Nonimmigrant aliens have been admitted to the United States temporarily and include, but are not limited to, foreign students (persons holding F visas) and exchange visitors (students holding J visas).] Nonimmigrant alien are not eligible for this exemption; contact the Office of Admissions and Records to determine whether your visa allows you to establish California residency.
