ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS: Change in W Notation Starting in Summer 2012
Starting in Summer 2012, the last day to withdraw from a class WITHOUT a W notation on your transcript will change. It will now be on the same day as the last day to enroll with an instructor's signature. For most Summer 2012 classes that are 6 weeks long, that day will be June 21, 2012. In Fall 2012, the last day to withdraw from FULL SEMESTER classes without a W notation will be September 2, 2012. Note: If you do not use WebAdvisor, you will have to withdraw in person on August 31.
To adjust to this change, you should [plan to enroll early and attend class beginning the first day](#) so that you can decide whether to remain in the class by the end of the second week. You should also [consult with a counselor before enrolling in classes](#) so that you have a clear idea of expectations in the class.
You will still be allowed to withdraw until Week 14 for full semester classes with a W notation.

Description

This course will enable students to earn college credit for learning or improving skills or knowledge on-the-job. Occupational Work Experience is "discipline-specific" in that students' job and learning objectives relate to the Work Experience course. There are no prerequisites or concurrent enrollment requirements, and there are no classroom meetings after the initial orientation. Students can earn up to 8 units per semester (for a total of 16 units). Units are Degree applicable and transferable. Units are awarded upon achievement of approved learning objectives. Each unit requires paid employees to document 75 hours (volunteers or unpaid employees - 60 hours) during the semester.


