

Scholarship APPLICATION CHECKLIST

All applicants must fill out and turn in all 4 pages of the application.

1. Scholarship Application

No handwritten applications accepted.

Fillable PDF form available on Mendocino College website on 1/2/17. Printed application packets available at all campus locations the first Tuesday in January

2. Essay Page

• Form included in application packet or attach a one-page essay (12 pt font minimum, single spaced, no more than one page)

3. Extra Curricular Activities & Signature Page

- Form included in application packet or attach a one-page listing
- Sign and date the application

All applicants must provide two letters

1 4. Two Recommendation Letters/Forms

- Forms included in application packet. At least one recommendation letter must be from an instructor (if you are a re-entry student [have been out of school for five or more years], then both recommendations can be from someone outside Mendocino College)
- One from someone who knows you well (not a family member/relative)

HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS ONLY

High School seniors must also provide their current high school transcripts.

5. High School Transcripts

(All **High School seniors must include current high school transcripts** with their application or the application is not accepted)
