Dear President Lehner:

The Committee on Substantive Change of the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges, met November 14-15, 2011 to review the Substantive Change Proposal from Mendocino College for the Lake Center, and the 24 degrees and seven certificates offered more than 50% at the location (attached).

The Committee approved the Mendocino College Proposal for the programs at the Center and would like to remind the College that a new Substantive Change Proposal will be required prior to the opening of the new Lake Center facility planned for January 2013. The Committee typically holds its meetings three times per year, once in the fall and twice in the spring; the dates are posted on the ACCJC website after the June Commission meeting. A final Proposal should be submitted 30 days prior to the scheduled meeting, and after the College is able to respond to all of the required elements in the June 2011 Substantive Change Manual.

It remains the College's responsibility to inform the Commission of any program change. Professional self-regulation is the most effective means of assuring integrity, effectiveness and quality.
